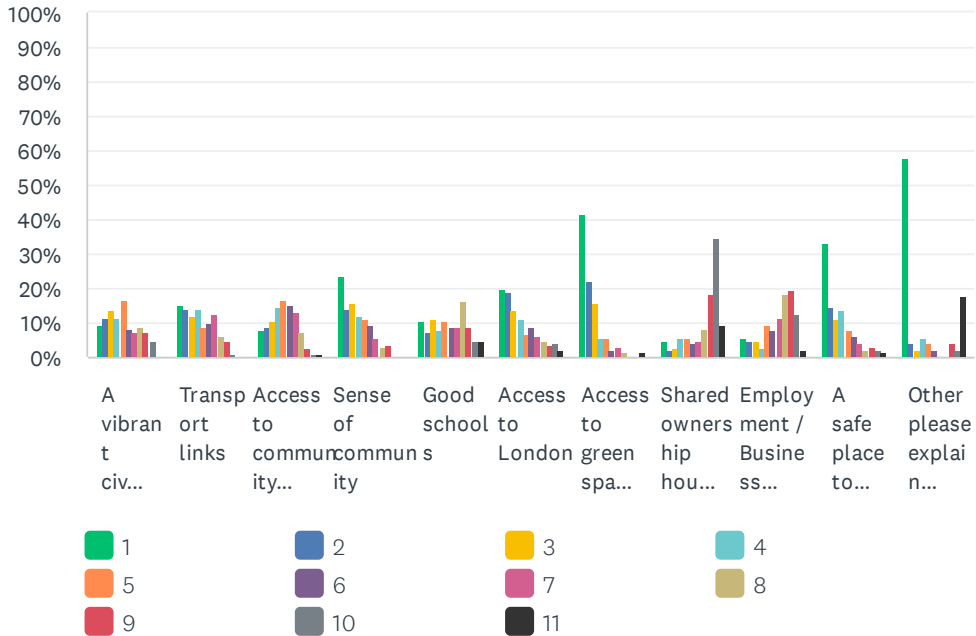

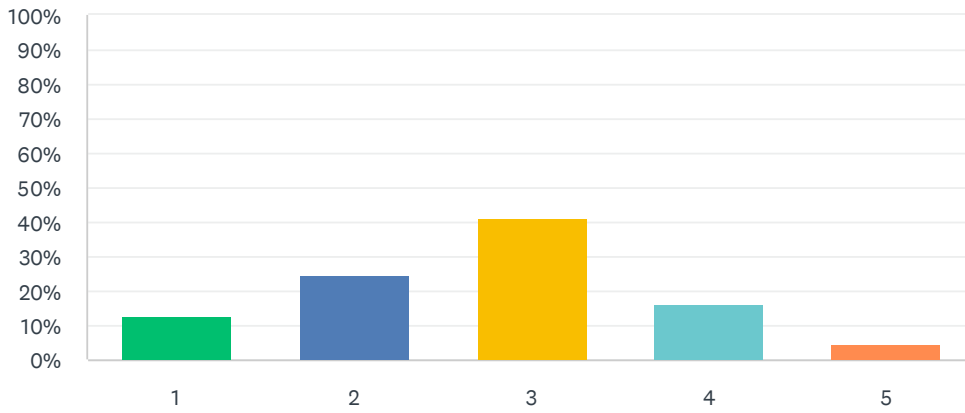

Q6 From what you know about the work Maidstone Borough Council (MBC) does, how would you rate the job they do for our community?

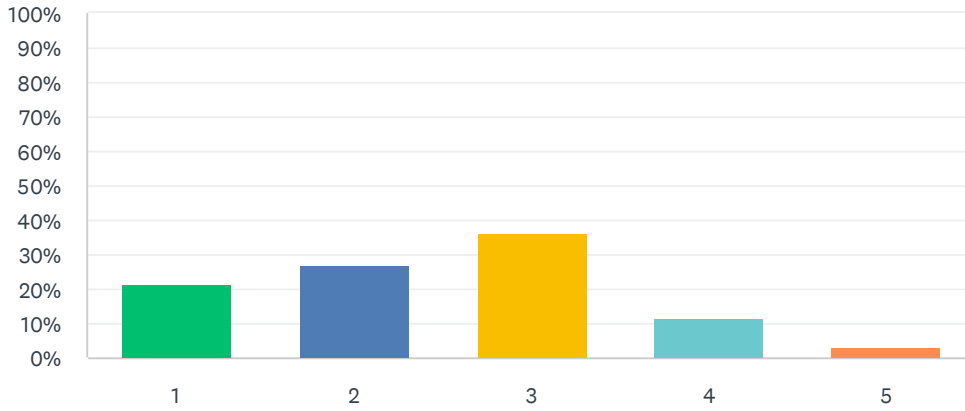

Q7 From what you know about the work Kent County Council (KCC) does, how would you rate the job they do for our community?

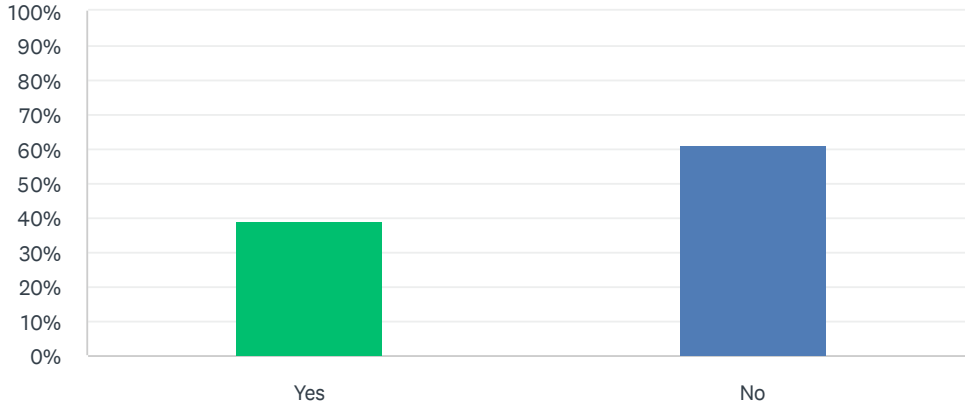

Q8 Staplehurst Parish Council offers community grants which can be accessed by local organisations within the Parish. Were you aware that community grants were available from the Parish Council?

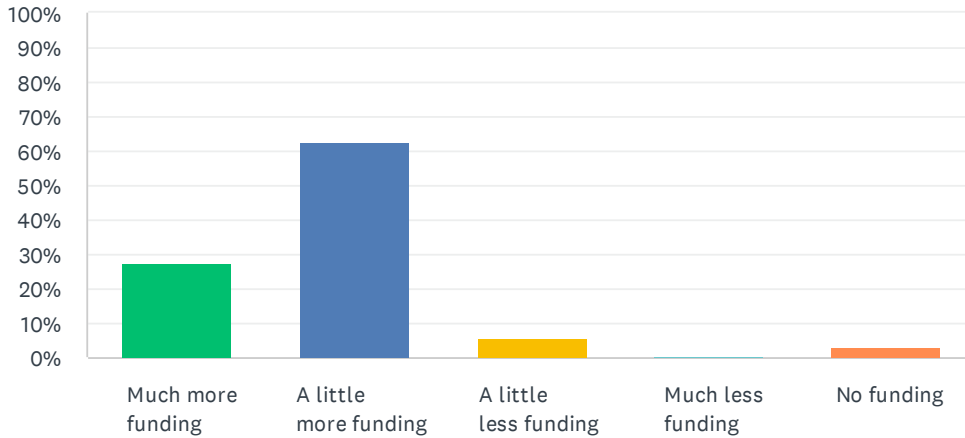

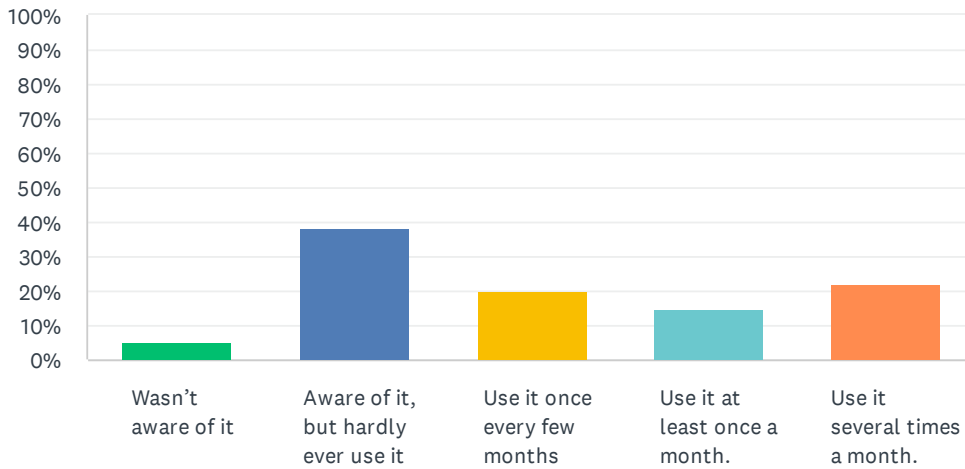

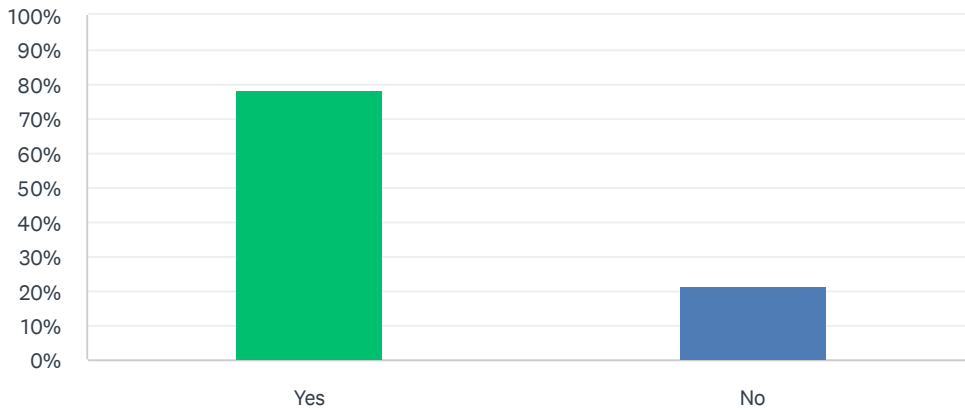

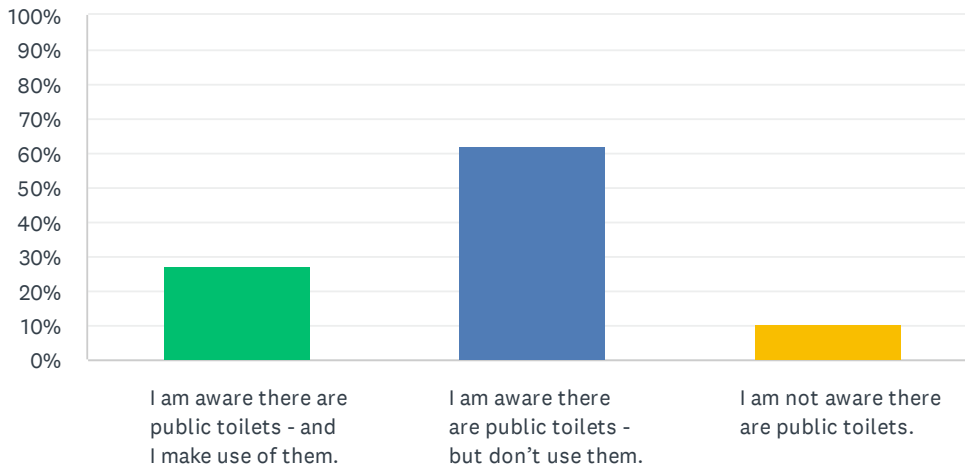

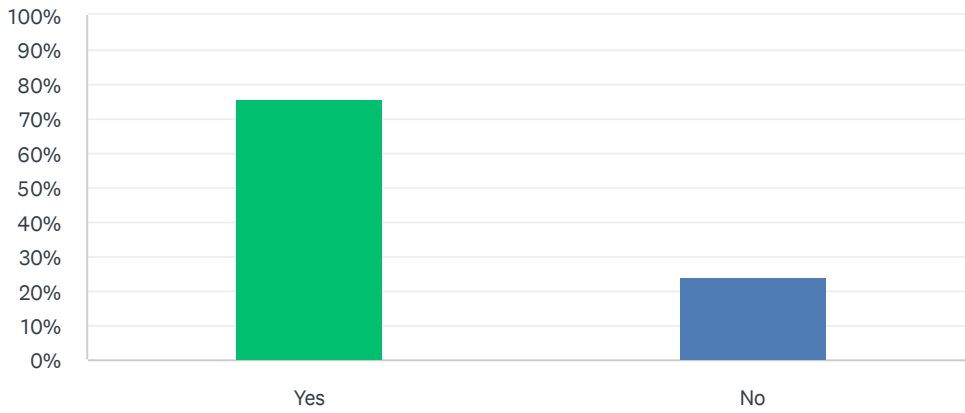

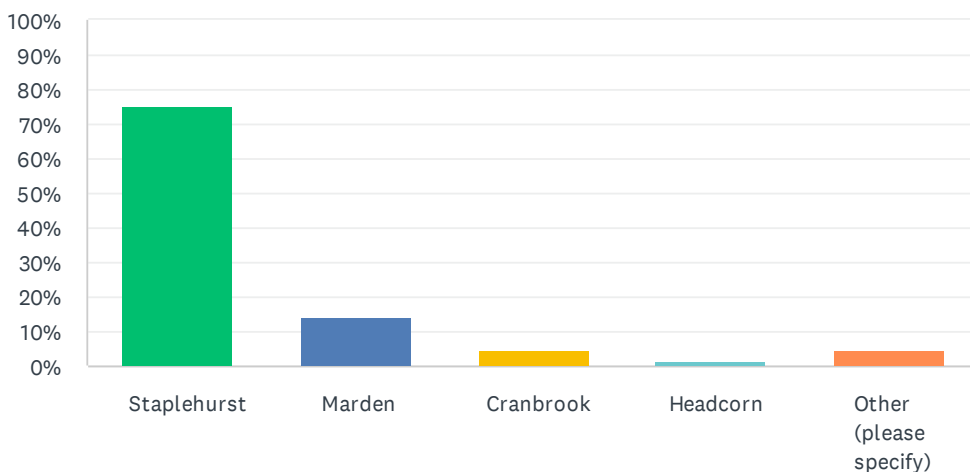

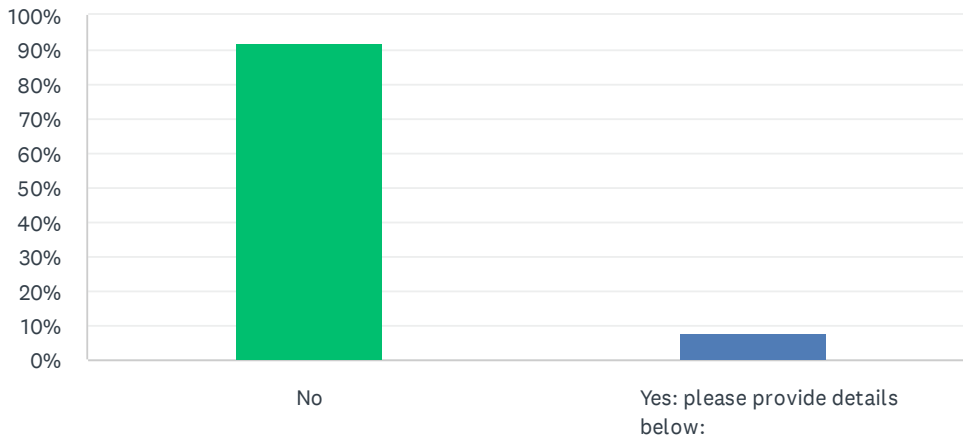

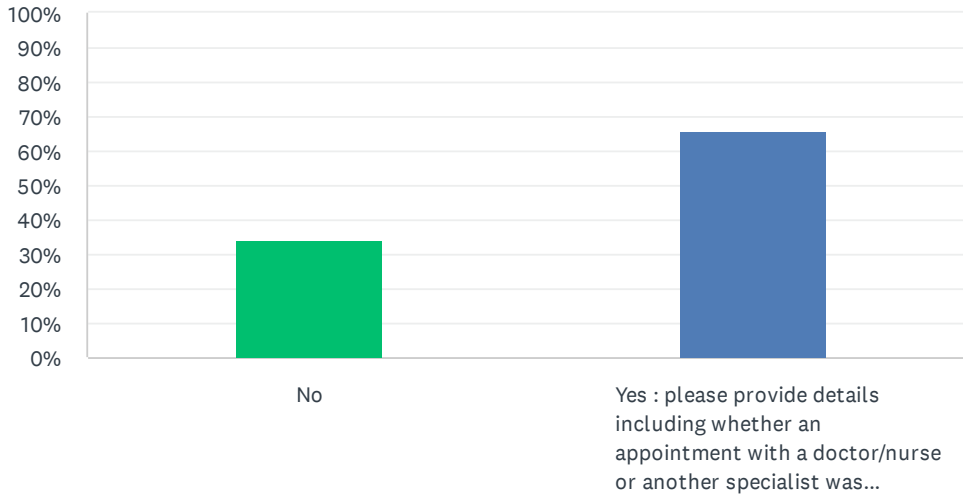

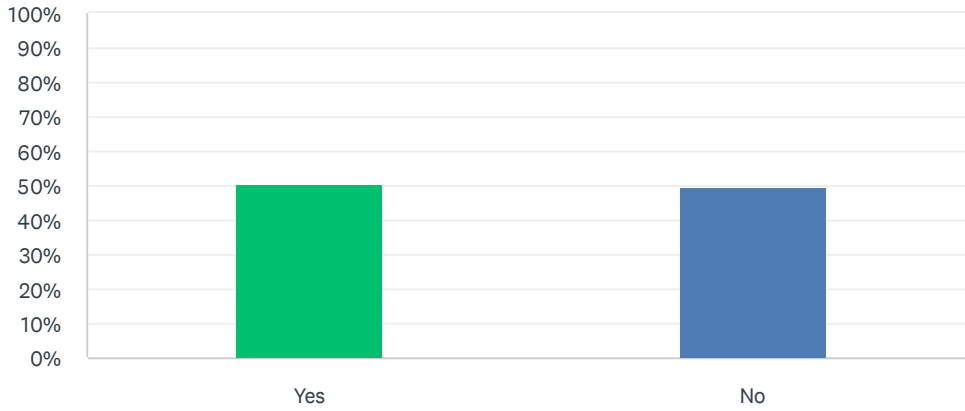

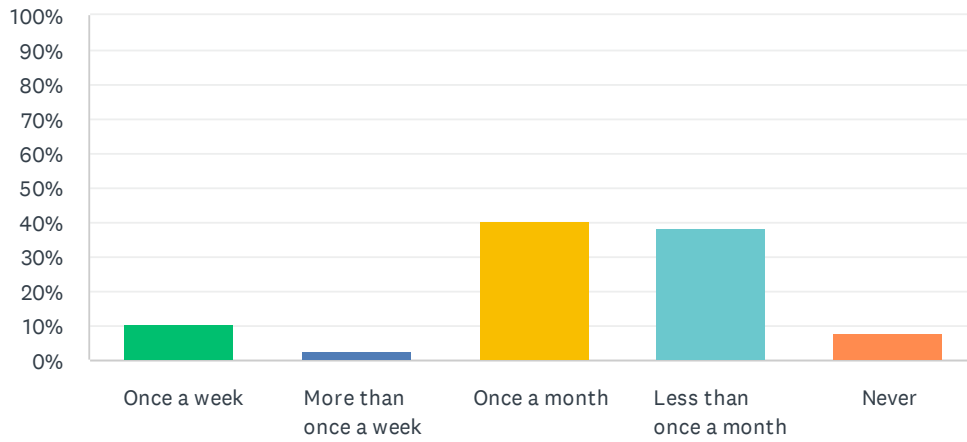

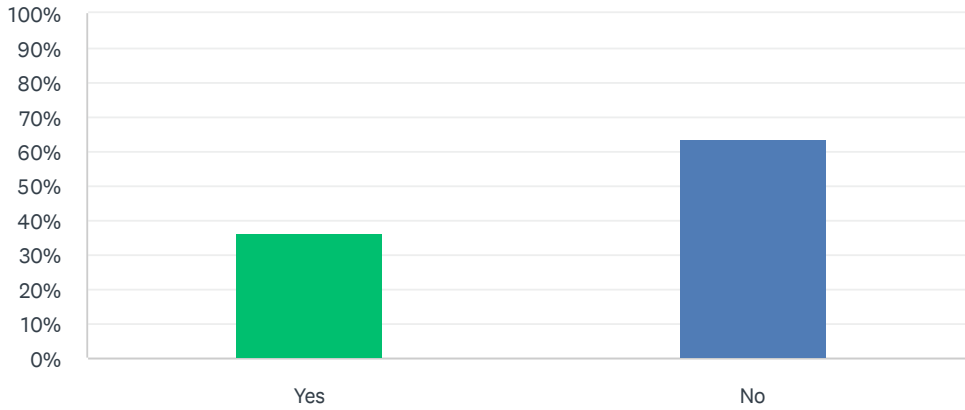

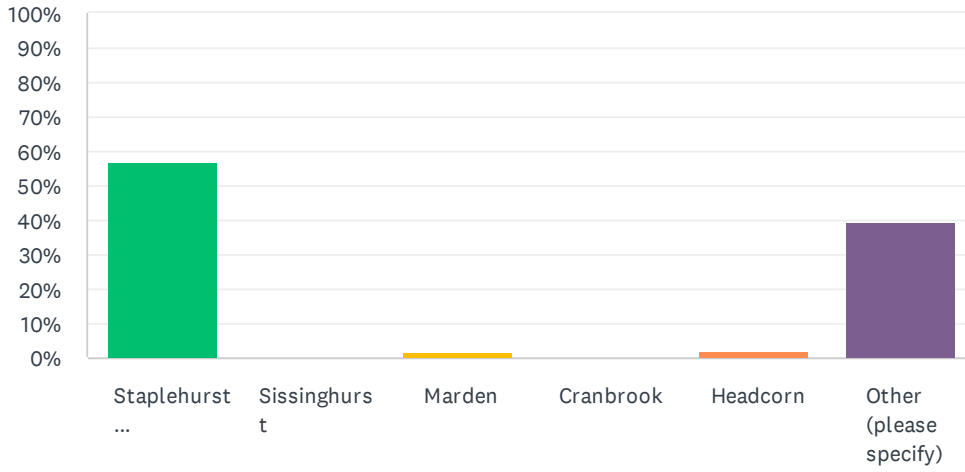

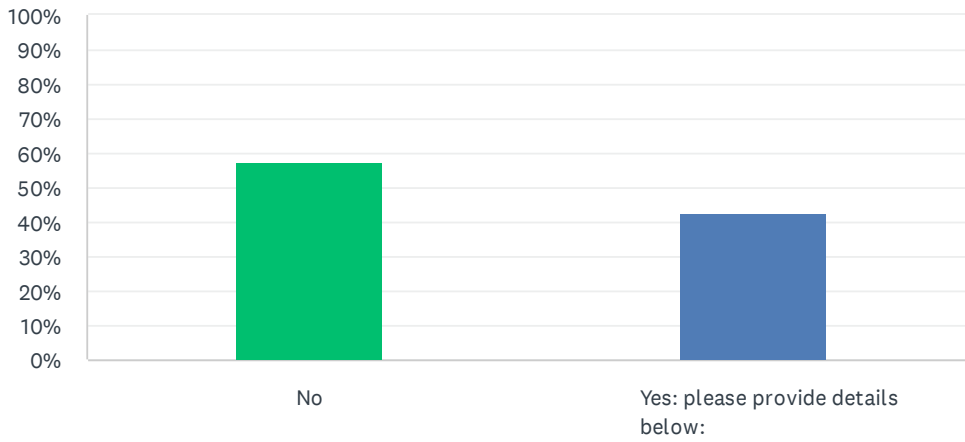

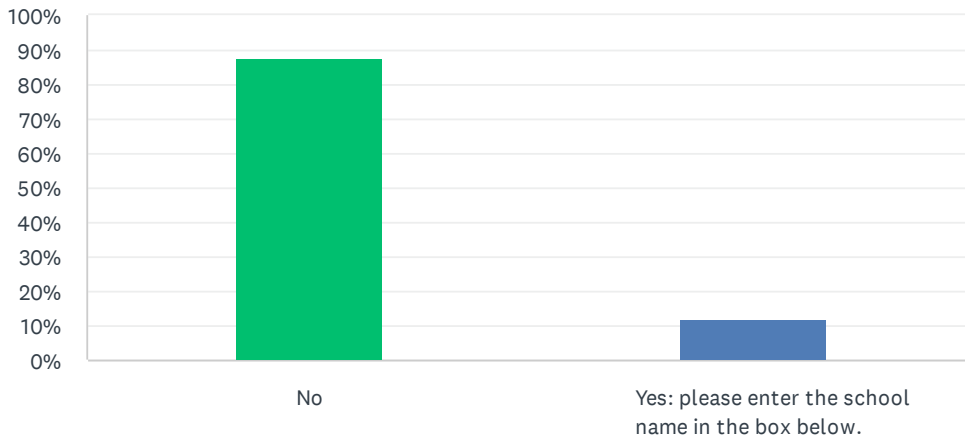

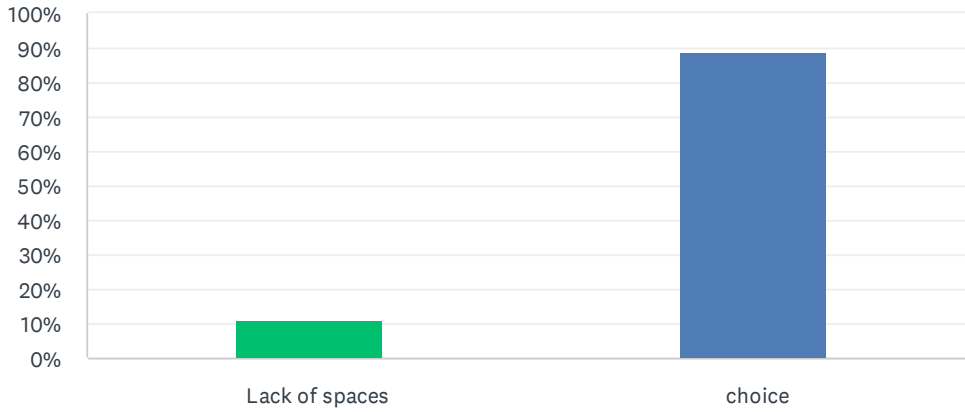

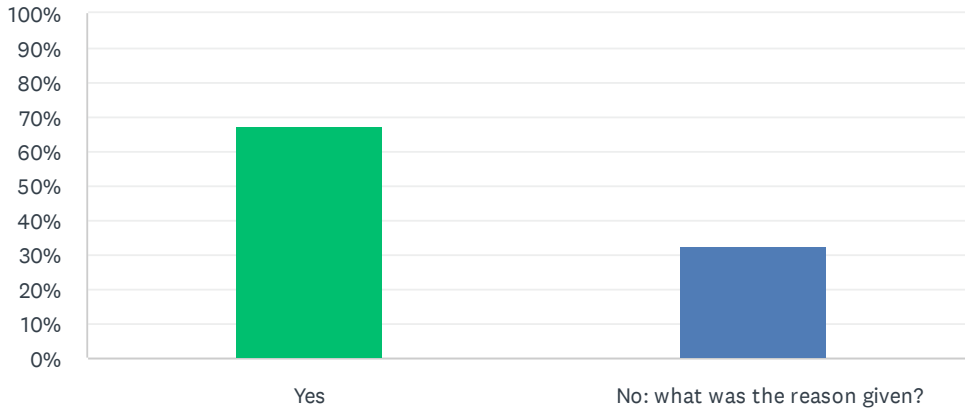

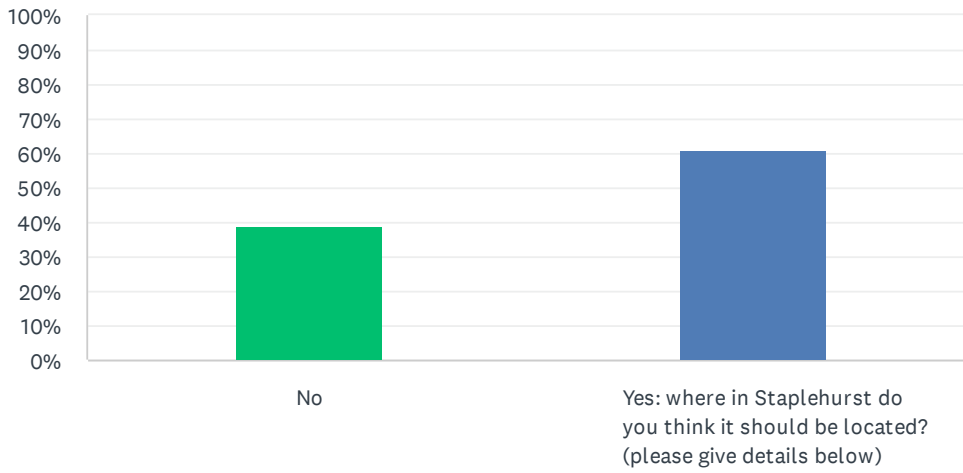

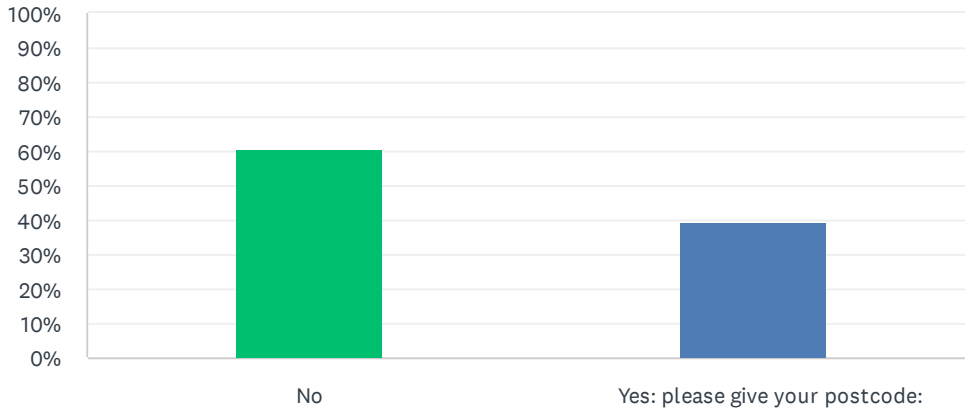

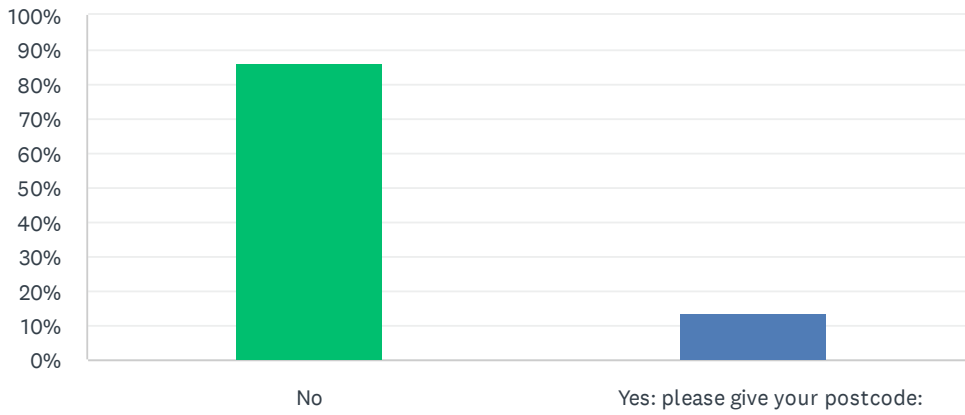

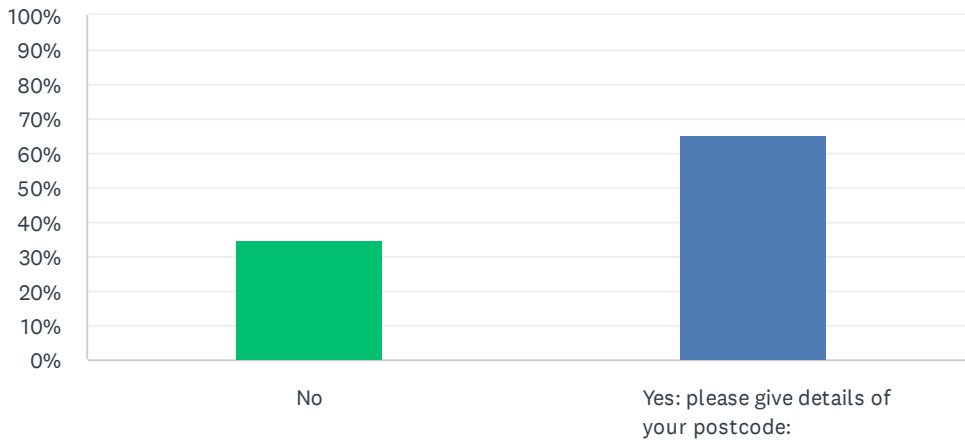

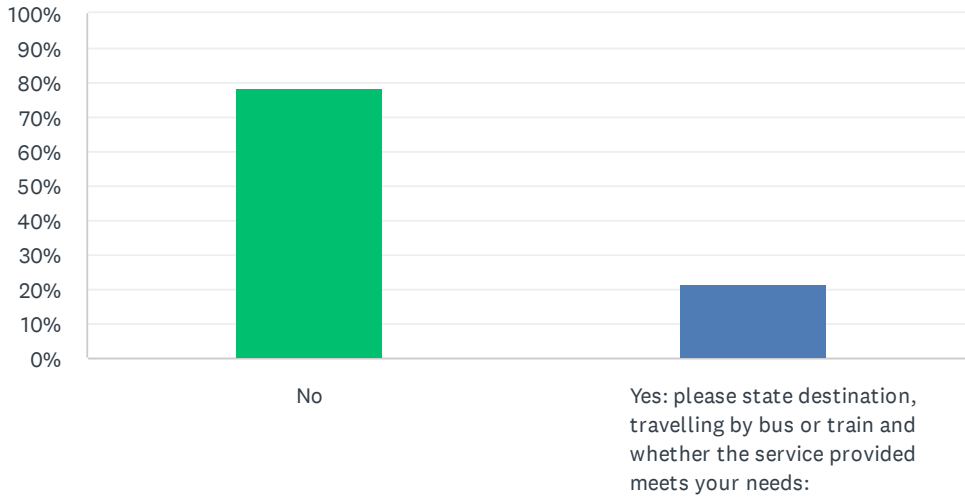

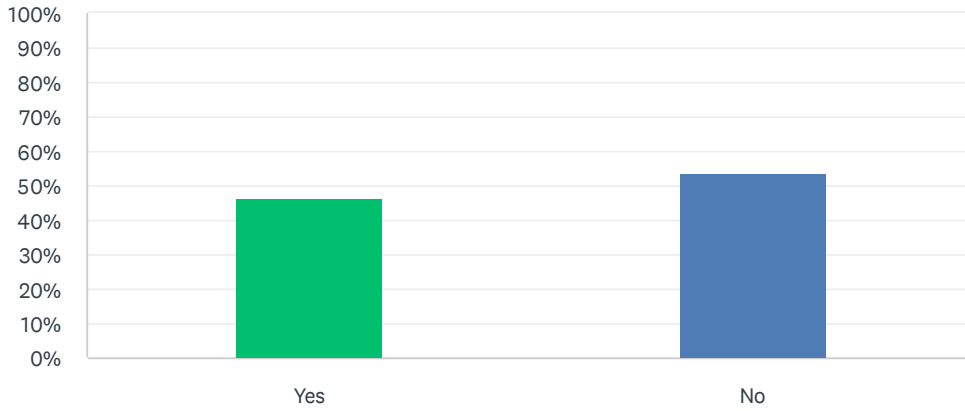

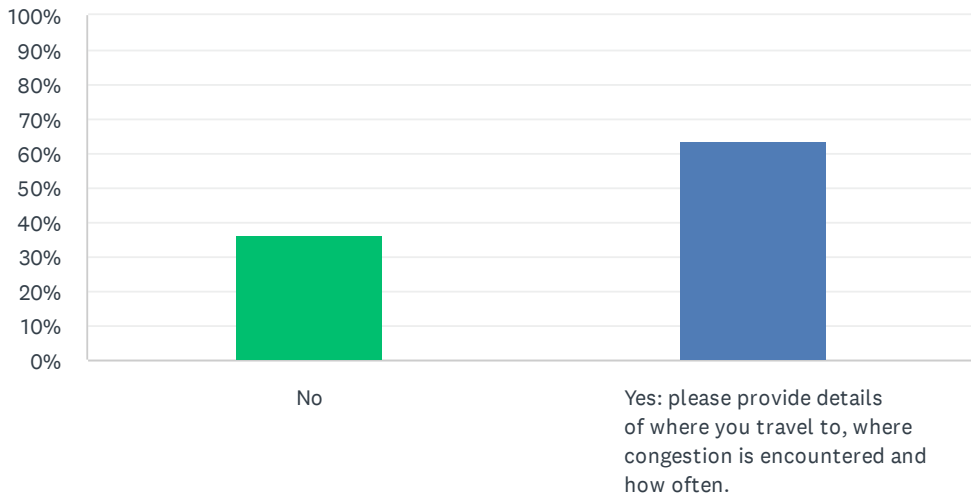

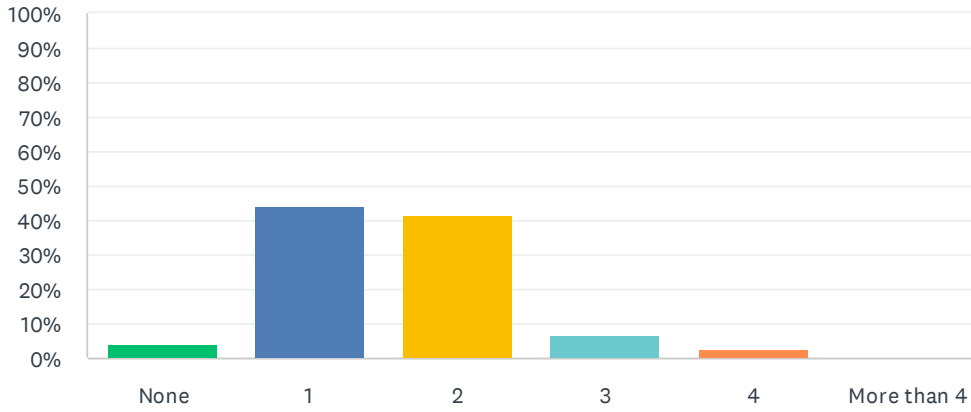

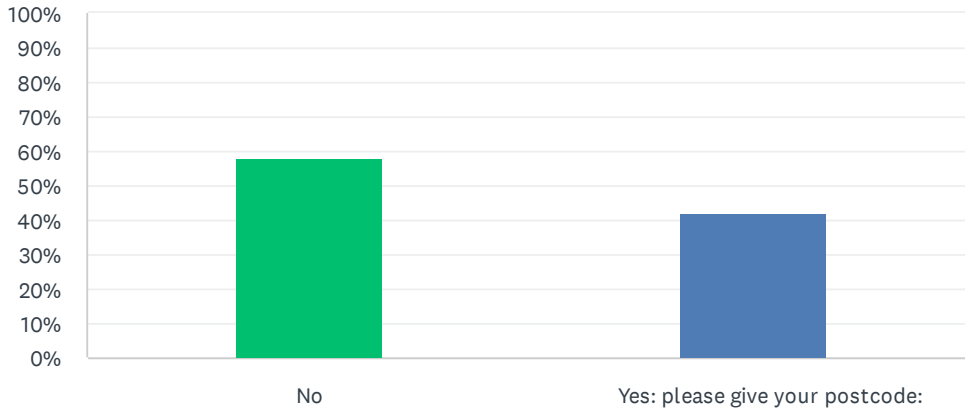

Q36 Do you experience “rat running” through estate roads by vehicles seeking to avoid the Headcorn/Marden Road traffic lights

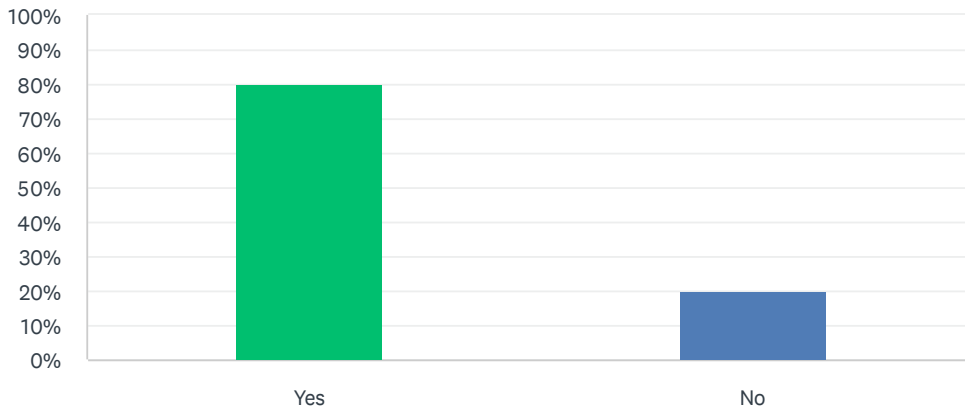

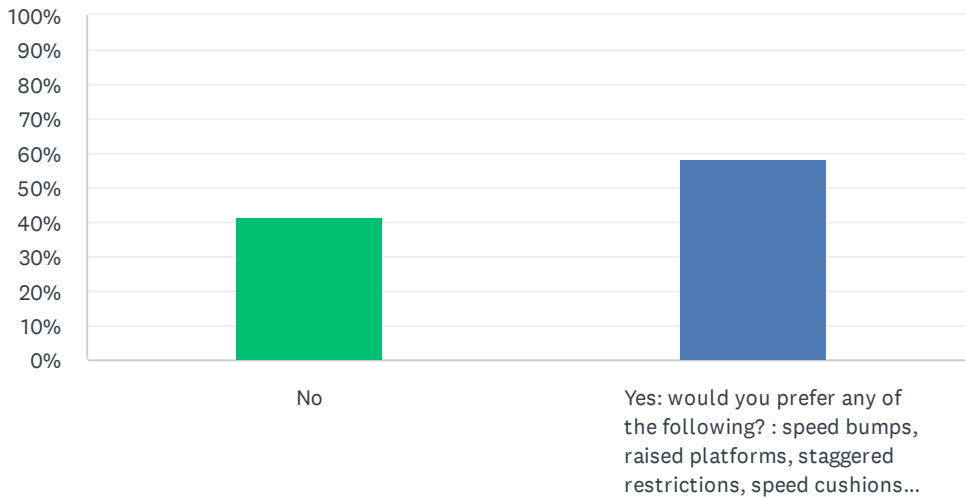

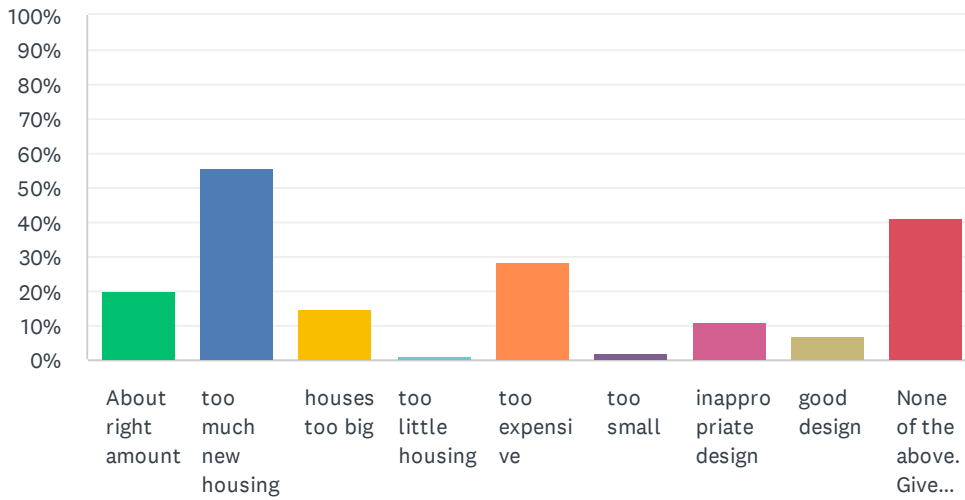

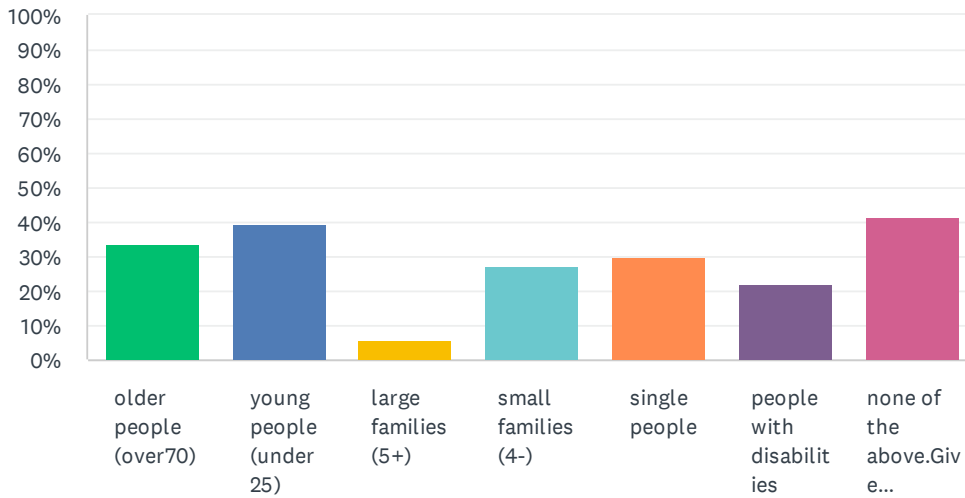

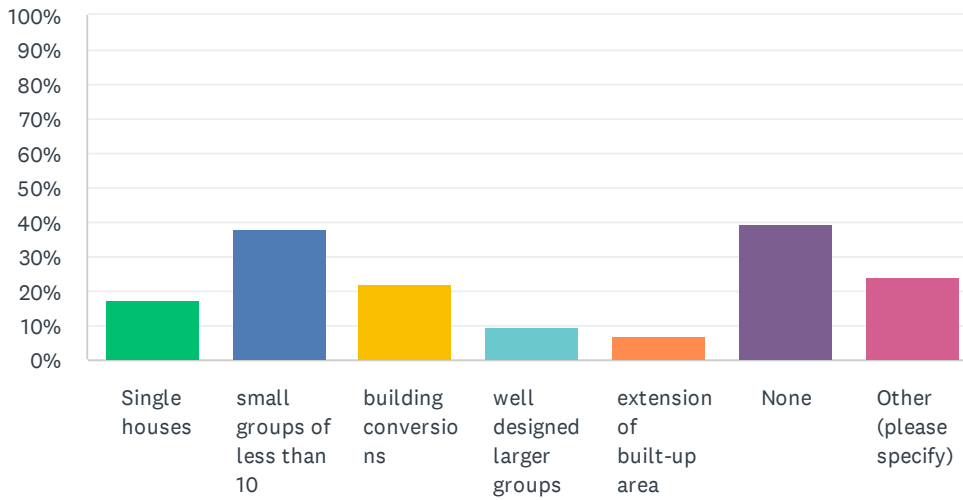

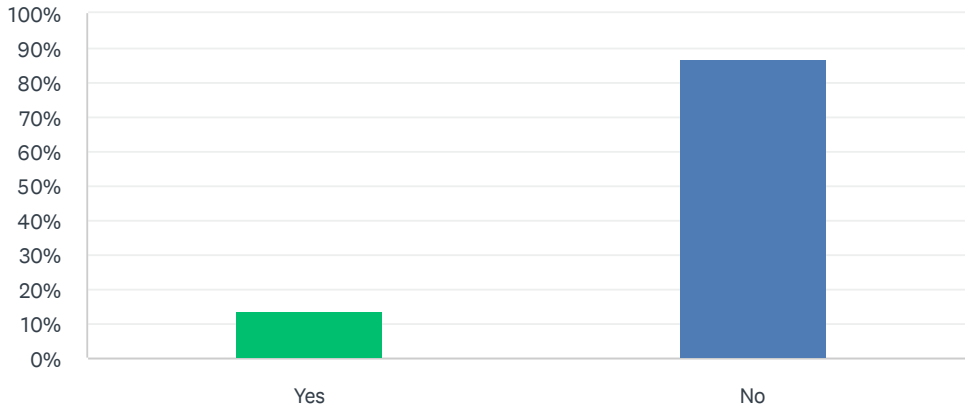

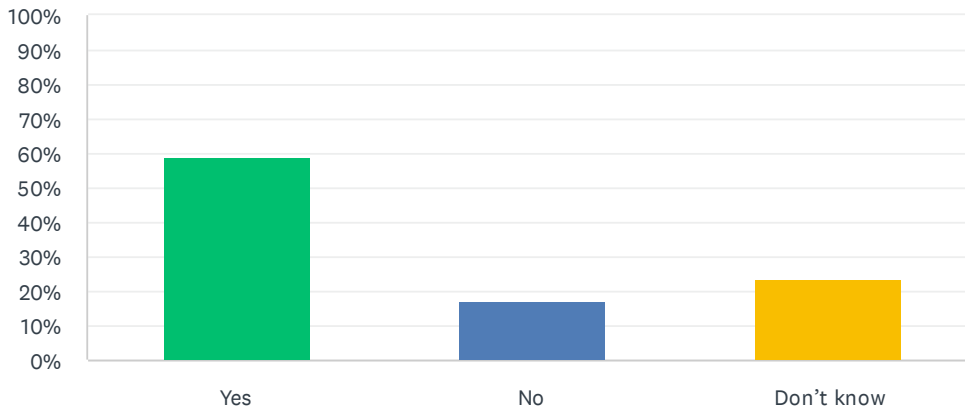

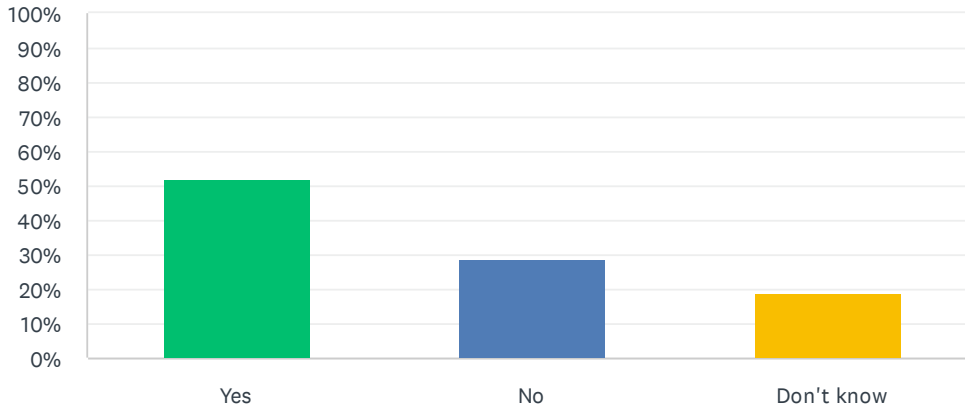

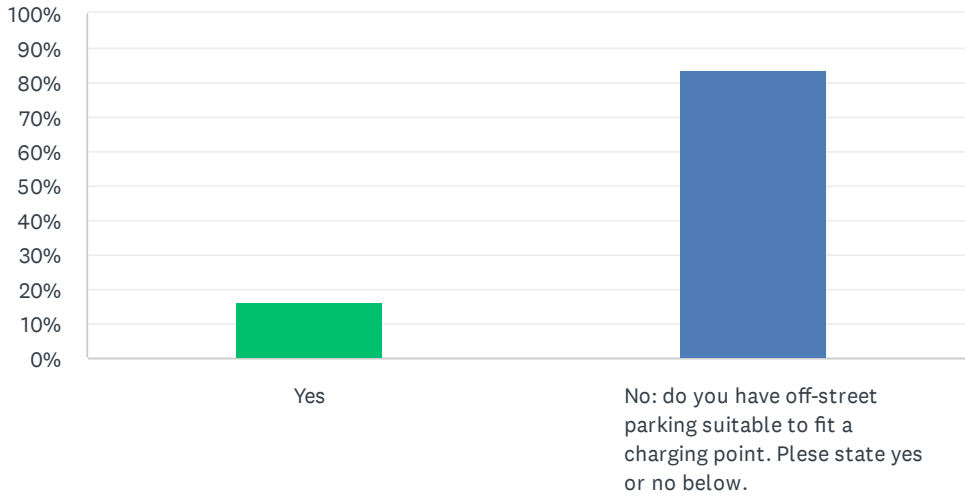

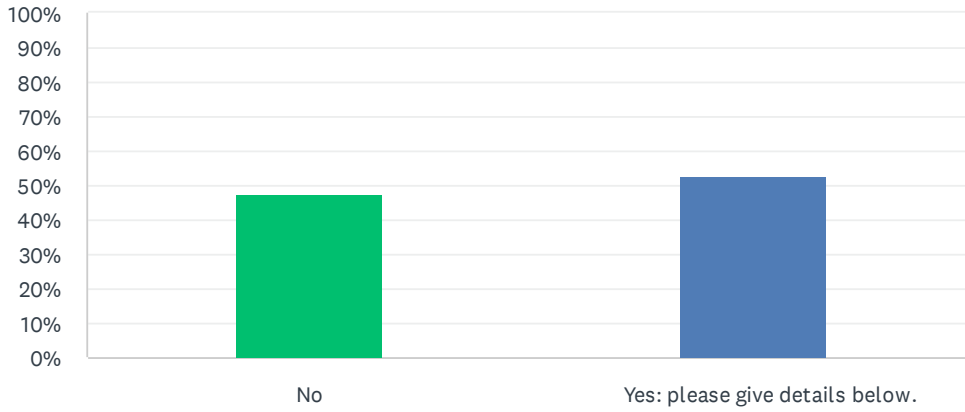

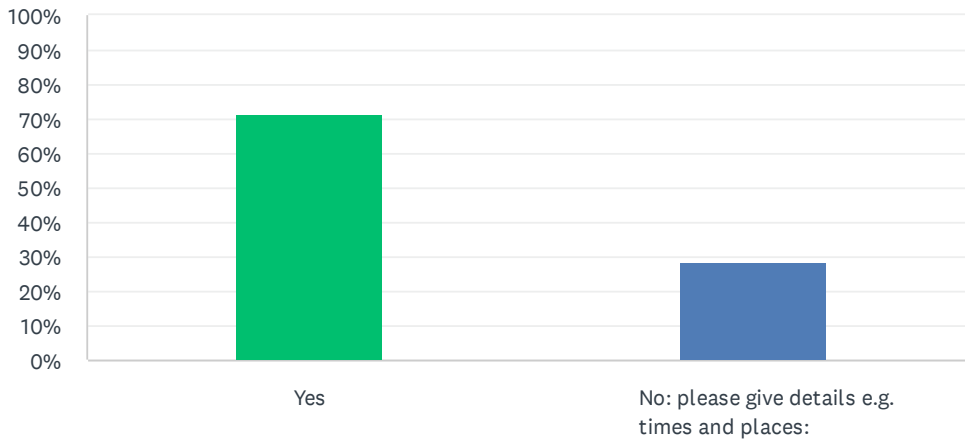

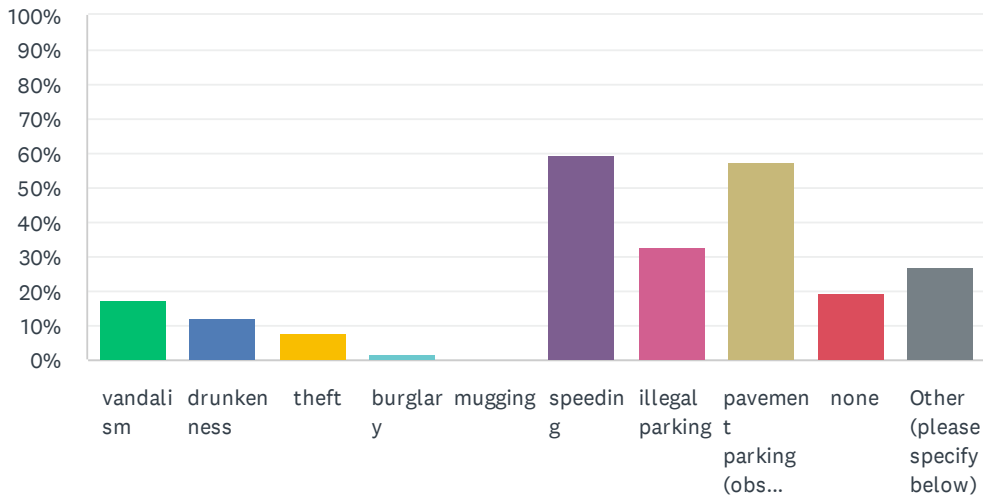

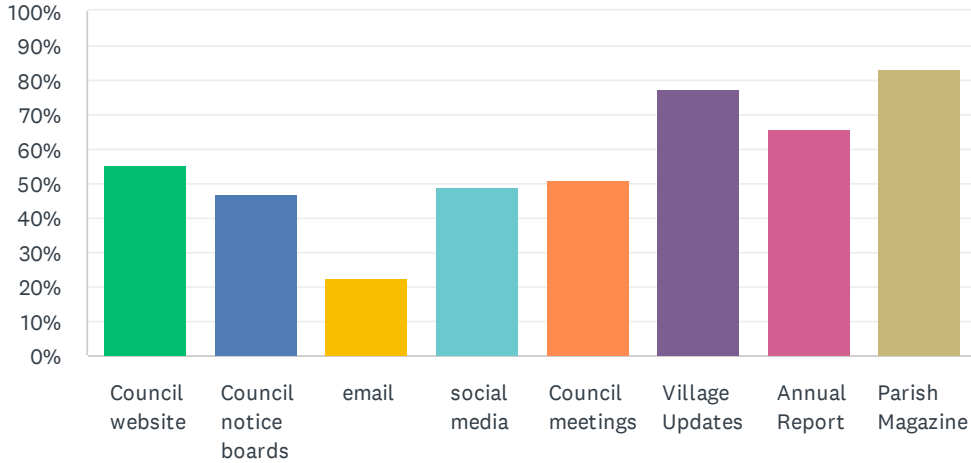

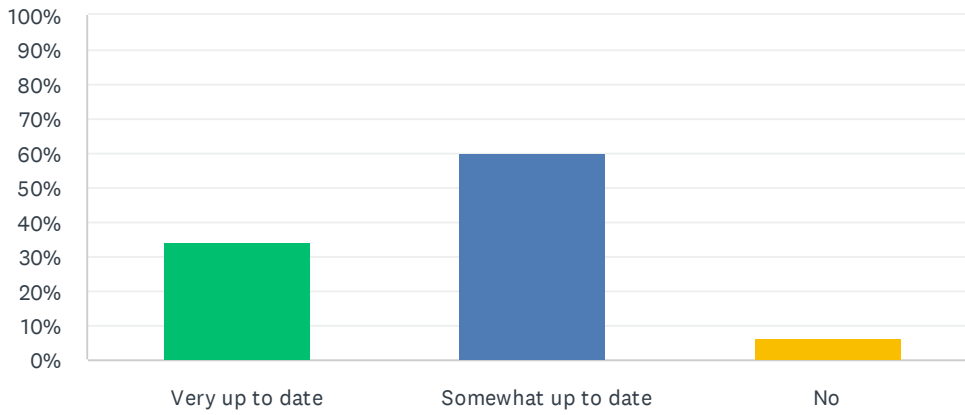
